



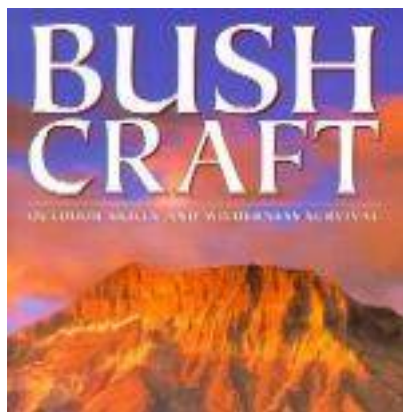
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Bush Craft: Outdoor Skills and Wilderness Survival.

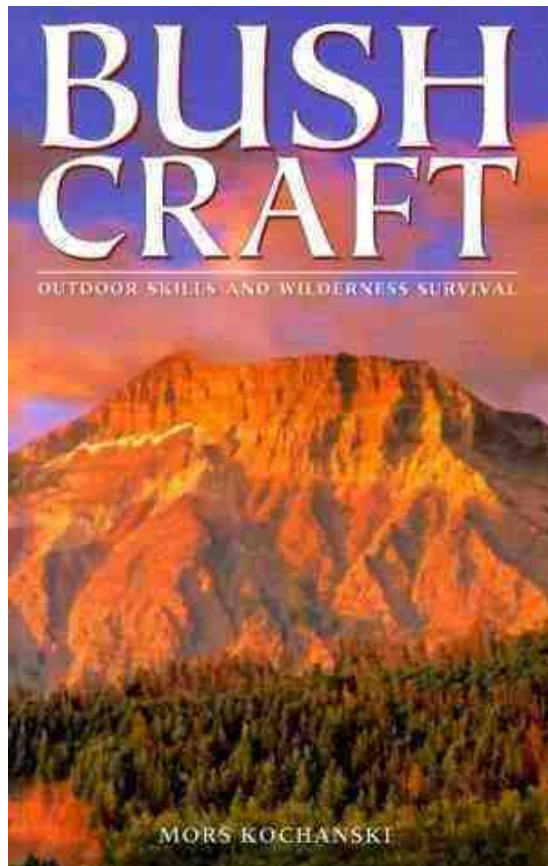

I found this book quite interesting, it spends some chapters, explaining how to use a small fixed blade for bushcrafting, as well as how to choose an axe, and how to use it properly, including securely felling trees.

A similar chapter is written on knives.

The fire and shelter chapter is very well documented, and can definitely turn useful.

It may prove difficult though for a lot of people to find a moose to skin and tan its hide[:)]

A book I recommend reading, again very different from the traditional "military survival" type of books, and rather about day to day life and resources in sub-arctic forests.
