## **Bush craft – camp fires**



Camp fires - half day option

Groups cooperate to collect wood from the forest and build a fire in the Suntrap grounds. If successful they use this to cook some toast!

#### Learning objectives

- to collaborate with others in a group to solve a problem or make a decision
- to develop some of the skills involved in group work, such as negotiating, problem-solving, debating
- to reflect on their participation and communication
- to develop a clear idea of what has to be done
- planning how to use materials, equipment and processes, and suggesting alternative methods of making if first attempts fail



# Some suggestions for visit preparation

1. Get pupils to undertake their own risk assessment for making fires in the forest.



### Follow on suggestions

- 1. Ask pupils to reflect on how well their team worked together.
- 2. Write instructions for how to make a fire.
